Dear Friends,

We are pleased to share with you the programs, activities, and accomplishments of the Jewish Women's Archive during its 2017-2018 fiscal year—and to thank you for your vital partnership in helping JWA achieve its mission.

It was a year in which truths that are central to JWA's mission and work became visible to the wider world in new ways.

As the #MeToo movement ignited in Fall 2017, we witnessed how women's stories, shared and amplified, can change the world. Following the tragic school shooting in Florida in February 2018, we saw the inspiring power of young people to lead social movements. And as our culture became increasingly divisive, it was evident how including and elevating diverse voices is necessary for productive civic dialogue. Over the course of the year, JWA's central premise proved to be more apt than ever: that the echoes of history reverberate in our own time, and that we can draw strength, clarity, and empathy from knowing our past and the stories of others.



As these events were unfolding, JWA was there to capture and contextualize them. **We created a #MeToo Archive**, inviting Jewish women to submit their #MeToo stories for safekeeping, and to help build a larger communal narrative. **JWA's Rising**

Voices Fellows showed solidarity with their fellow teen activists by using their writing and words to advocate for change in gun laws. And **we partnered with Jewish social justice organizations to spotlight the underrepresented stories of Jewish women of color** in #ShareHerStory. In these and many other ways, JWA's unique nexus of feminism, Judaism, history, and social justice provided a lens for understanding and action in our world today.

Other highlights of JWA's work in 2017-2018 include:

- Sharing the stories of “ordinary extraordinary” women in two new collections: *We Celebrate* and *Boston's Soviet Jewry Movement*;
- Cultivating young Jewish leaders in the fifth cohort of the *Rising Voices Fellowship*;
- Exploring the diversity of Jewish women's impact and experiences—from peace activists to Hollywood producers—in seven new episodes of *JWA's podcast, Can We Talk?*, and hosting our first-ever live podcast event;
- Elevating diverse voices on the JWA blog, *Jewish Women, Amplified*, relaunched with a new name and new features;
- Initiating an important update and redesign of the *Encyclopedia of Jewish Women*, the most visited resource on jwa.org;
- Creating opportunities for connection and rich conversation at numerous *events in the community*; and
- Shaping conversations about Jewish feminist leadership in national media.

Alongside timely programming, we worked to position the organization internally and externally for growth. In FY18, JWA's Board of Directors began a visioning and strategic-planning process, the result of which will provide *a focused road map for the next three years*. JWA was also selected for Project Accelerate, a two-year fellowship for high-performing Jewish organizations poised to enter a new stage. This fellowship provides JWA with capacity-building opportunities and matching funds—and is a timely opportunity that aligns well with our strategic plans for organizational growth.



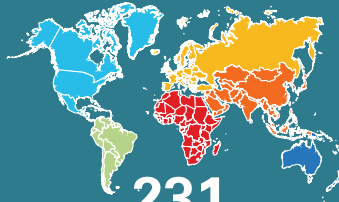
